CAMBRIDGE — For students who are used to cramped and older quarters at Chalmers Street Public School, Alison Park Public School and Lincoln Avenue Public School, walking through the foyer of the brand-new Moffat Creek Public School is a whole new experience.

The three-floor school on Myers Road is open and bright with floor-to-ceiling glass windows. The foyer features four pressed-glass panels embedded with plants to signify the importance of the nearby Moffat Creek watershed

Grade 3 teacher Vicky McKenna said teachers are working on “community circles” so students can get to know each other. Boundary walks with classes will be organized outside the building to ensure students know where to play and be safe.

Christine McEathron said she was impressed with the high ceilings and the size of the school after having her sons attend Chalmers Street Public School. “The technology in general is amazing compared to when I was a kid,” she said.
