Escarpment Hall, the main circulation / crush space, forms a dramatic interior main street. Its backdrop

of layered limestone and wood finishes is suitable for corporate, recreation and education activities. The new facility enables many opportunities to showcase artistic works. The Woodland Art Gallery will accommodate both individual and group visual art exhibitions.

The Visual Art Centre, on the second floor, has outstanding views and is filled with natural light. It has two main studios, one for adults and one for children. The Public Library, set along Main Street, creates a vibrant, urban edge. The western end is dominated by a massive limestone fireplace. The facility features expanded space for in-depth collections, resources and programs.

Milton's new 500 seat live-performance Theatre captures the fundamental theme of community. The theatre will showcase drama, music, orchestra, dance, concerts, cinema, lectures, and conferences. It incorporates a large Multi-purpose Room, which will be used for theatrical presentations and also serve a wide range of community events.

Milton Centre for the Arts is a high performance Green building, designed to achieve LEED® Silver certification. It is designed to make optimum use of natural light and fresh air, minimize water and power consumption and reduce site impact, waste and emissions.
